**Eligible students are currently in K-7<sup>th</sup> grades. An application and essay are required. Awards of \$500-\$2000 will be given annually.**

*Essay question: This year’s theme is “Through love, serve one another.” What does this verse mean to you and how have you lived this out over this school year.*

\_\_\_\_\_ **Knights of Columbus Scholarship:** Maintains an “A” average for the first 3 quarters; exhibits leadership skills inside and outside the classroom.

**Eligible students are currently in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. An application, essay, and interview are required. Two scholarships of \$500 awarded annually.**

*Essay prompt (200 word minimum): “My favorite saint and how they help me to be a better person”*

\_\_\_\_\_ **Herb Williams Scholarship:** Student athlete who has attended St. Edward School for multiple years; preferably the student plays multiple sports. Shows true competitiveness while displaying great leadership. Shows true sportsmanship. Maintains a “C” average for the first 3 quarters.

**Eligible students are currently in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. An essay is required. Two scholarships of \$2500 will be awarded.**

*Essay question: How do you demonstrate Christian sportsmanship on and off the court/field?*

\_\_\_\_\_ **Coach Cat Scholarship:** Student athlete who has attended St. Edward School for multiple years; preferably the student plays multiple sports. Shows true competitiveness while displaying great leadership. Shows true sportsmanship. Maintains a “C” average for the first 3 quarters.

**Eligible students are currently in 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade. An essay is required. Two scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded.**

*Essay question: How do you demonstrate Christian sportsmanship on and off the court/field?*
